Mitigation actions have been published and sent to all parents in a document entitled – "Training Protocols for Parents and Players".

A coach monitors all activities outside the hall on arrival and departure. Timings are staggered to ensure minimum contact between groups and a one-way system is in place.

Prior to each training session, and during if necessary, the players are reminded of the key aspects covered under the protocol.

The Sports Hall

The hall has been assessed for risk as follows:

There is an open storage area which balls can land in. This must be prevented by hanging netting outside of the wooden barrier. If a ball does go into the storage area, players are not allowed to go in and recover it.

Mats will need to be brought in and out from the storage area. This must be done by adults.

Running of nets must be undertaken by coaches who have received the "Net Management Instruction / Best Practice" document. Only the net against the wall can be used as a running net. The second net is for one to one coaching only with any hard ball not being hit out of the net.

If doors are open for ventilation, any balls going through the doors must be retrieved by an adult.
